- **The Path to Life**

Materials: [Pathway PDF](#), writing utensils. Say, "The book of Romans shows us that Jesus is the Lord of life. While we were sinners, Jesus died for us so that we could have life in Him (Romans 5:8). How does it make you feel to know that Jesus rules over everything, even death? What do you think it looks like for you to have life in Jesus? As followers of Jesus, we've been given the amazing gift of experiencing life with God. Now that you've heard that Jesus is the Lord of life, how do you want to respond to Him today? Do you want to spend some time praising Him for being ruler over everything? Do you have something you want to ask Him? Do you want to pray for someone who needs to hear about Jesus?" Give your child the [Pathway PDF](#) or draw your own, and allow them to respond. They may want to write or draw praises on the path. They may want to write a prayer to Jesus, the Lord of life. Or they may want to ask God to give them the name of someone who needs to hear the good news of Jesus.
