Though they came from different places and cultural backgrounds, the Holy Spirit unified them. God's Spirit still unifies His people today. We may be very different from other believers, but no matter how many differences we have, the Holy Spirit still brings us together. Read Psalm 133:1. What are some ways we as believers can continue to be unified? The Holy Spirit also unifies us with believers all over the world. One way we can help believers far from us is to pray for them."
