

Preschool Lesson:

Jesus is King!

Based on: Matthew 21:1–11; Mark 11:1–11; Luke 19:28–38

Get Creative!

- Make a palm branch: Print [this template](#) or draw your own and invite your child to color and decorate it. Place it in a prominent location to remind your family that Jesus is King!
- Make a crown: Print [this template](#) or draw your own and invite your child to color and decorate it. Even though Jesus didn't wear a crown in this part of the Big God Story, we can decorate one to help us remember that Jesus is King.

Act it Out!

- Gather some coats and place them on the ground, forming a path across the room. Say, "When Jesus rode into town on the donkey, people laid their coats on the ground. We're going to pretend we're donkeys and walk across the coats. Don't forget to make donkey sounds!"
- Roll play and dress up as royalty. Be sure to include a discussion about Jesus, our true King who loves us!
