Make it Stick

- **Is it Empty?** Collect 3-4 containers with lids (not transparent) and put a rock in one. Invite your child to guess which one has the rock inside of it. Now check the containers. "Is there anything inside? No, it's empty or Yes, you found it!" Next, have your child hide the rock while you guess! (Helps your child begin to understand the empty tomb)
- **Roll a "Rock" Relay** Gather a ball and some masking tape to mark a start and finish line. Ask, "What was rolled in front of Jesus' tomb? A big rock! We're going to pretend this ball is a rock. We need to roll it from here to there." Feel free to add some obstacles!
- **Jesus is Alive!** Gather a paper cup or small container, some potting soil and seeds. Say, "Today we learned that Jesus died for us and then came alive again after three days. What are some other things that are alive?" (Invite answers) "We're going to put some dirt in your cup and then we're going to plant seeds in the dirt. We will put it in the sunshine and give it lots of water every day. The flower/plant is alive, and every time you look at it, it will remind you that Jesus is alive too!" You can also decorate your cup before planting.
