• Making the Lesson Real

Prepare some simple addition math questions (optional: use flash cards) for your child and have them answer them. Ask, "**How were you able to answer these questions? If you had never studied any math before, do you think you could have answered these questions? It's easy to give an answer in math if you know how to find the answer. Once you learn how to find the answer, you can use flashcards to get better and better at it, becoming quicker and more confident as you do. Giving an answer about Jesus works the same way. The more we study God's Word, the better we know the story of Jesus. The more we talk about it - at church or with our friends - the easier it becomes to give an answer.**"
